CNPA Volunteer of the Year

Without volunteers, CNPA would not exist. *The CNPA Volunteer of the Year Award* recognizes an outstanding volunteer who stands out for his/her contribution(s) during the past year. The *Volunteer of the Year* will be recognized at the Business Meeting at the CNPA Convention.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Nominee must have volunteered during the year in which they are nominated.
- Recognition can be for a single contribution or overall volunteerism for the year.
- Current members of the CNPA Board and the Awards Committee are not eligible.

Nomination Process:

- A Volunteer of the Year Nomination Form must be submitted by a CNPA member in good standing. Self-nominations will be accepted. Nominees may also be identified and submitted by the CNPA Board.
- Volunteer of the Year nomination must include a description of the nominee's volunteer contributions to CNPA, how their contributions advance CNPA's mission and an explanation of why the candidate should be considered
- Nominations open on Oct. 1 and must be received by Oct. 31.
